Breakfast sign-up: We are doing W,T,F. JoEllen oversees all dinners and Sandy is in charge of all food money. JoEllen confirmed to Tim we are doing 3 days and Flora has 3. Sandy asks all to please sign up tonight!! Need more people!!! Noah said his son and dil will help. We serve from 6-10, new menu this year. Be there early. Clean up right after so church can get in.

Chicken day sign-up Sandy says doing good but need people for Breakfast. Still have a few slots open. JoEllen says Lowell will be out there to help but can't carry chicken trays anymore. We did change the menu this year due to last year running out of coleslaw and tomatoes, substitute of baked beans, will give option. Two crock pots, switch out . Potatoes scrubbing 9am Friday at hall. May get need Prairie to help scrub. Sandy will talk to Ruth B. or Lyle, Marlene in charge of pork chop day. We will do coleslaw ahead that morning.

JoEllen showed us her sketch on the new museum will look like, 24x48 w/12 ft porch. Vaulted, will be insulated but not barn wood, loft over back end for storage and nonpublic bathroom. Windows on sides like a dairy barn, will ramp for wheel chair accessible, 2 doors will look like barn doors, railing around porch, inside insulated, height inside wall is 10 ft. not drywall. Sherry wants the outside to be dark blue. We want a 100 yr building. This is a concept drawing. Tim asked about heat and AC? Discussing, not sure. Has 3 ft frost footing and poured floor, will be raised up 15 inches off ground to be away from flooding. Biggest concern the fairboard says it will not be a money maker for fairboard, but they will own it and maintain

it. It has to be cost effective. Quote from Haas was \$ 46,294. Preliminary Concrete 16k . We have about 200k to work with. Still a lot of work to do. Solar trees. Wind power? Alternative energy sources to keep cost down. Solar panels on the well house. Well house is about 4 or 5 feet away. Very close.
